

Setting Up Your HaloGuard with Android

On your Phone:

Step 1: Download the HaloGuard App on your phone and sign up to an account.

Step 2: Log in using your mobile phone number, then the OTP code that will be sent to you. Accept all app permissions.

Step 3: Select “My Guardians”, tap the + and add your Guardians. They will receive an SMS with instructions on becoming your Guardian.

Step 4: Launch the Galaxy Wearable app, select Galaxy Watch on the screen and tap continue.

Step 5: Your phone will scan to find your watch and a code will appear. If the code from your watch matches the code on your phone, tap confirm. If the code does not match or does not appear, restart both your phone and the watch.

Step 6: Agree to the terms and conditions, allow all permissions and follow the on-screen prompts to connect your watch to your phone. Remember to add your Samsung account and your Google account when asked.

On your Watch:

Step 7: Install the HaloGuard app from the Google Play Store and log in with your phone number. You will receive another OTP code to sign in.

Step 8: Press Allow/Allow while using app for all permissions.

Step 9: Set HaloGuard as the double press button. Go to Watch Settings, tap Buttons and Gestures, tap Double Press, then select HaloGuard. Go back to Settings, tap Battery, tap Sleeping Apps, then press and hold HaloGuard to remove from sleeping apps

Tips:

- You may need to install the Galaxy Wearable App or update to the latest version.
- If you do not have a Samsung or Google account, you will need to create these to proceed.
- Check your software on your phone and watch is up to date. HaloGuard requires Android 14 and above to work as expected.
- If you disallow any permissions the HaloGuard Apps will not function as expected.
- Do some test alarms with your Guardians
