

Setting Up HaloGuard on Android

A quick guide to connecting the Samsung Galaxy Watch and phone.

On the Phone

1

Download HaloGuard

Download the HaloGuard app from the Google Play Store and create an account. Log in with mobile number and OTP code.

2

Allow Permissions

Tap Allow, or Allow While Using App, for every permission requested. For the three special permissions, toggle on HaloGuard when prompted.

3

Add the Guardians

Go to My Guardians, tap +, and add the Guardians. They will receive an SMS with instructions to download HaloGuard and accept.

4

Galaxy Wearable

Download/open the Galaxy Wearable app, select Galaxy Watch, and tap Continue.

5

Pair the Watch

Let the mobile scan for the watch, then confirm the matching code. Follow the Galaxy Wearable prompts to connect.

On the Watch

6

Install on the Watch

Install the HaloGuard app from the Google Play Store and log in with the phone number and OTP code.

7

Set the Double Press Button

Go to Settings / Buttons and Gestures / Double Press, then select HaloGuard.

FYI: A Samsung and Google account are necessary. HaloGuard requires Android 14 and above to operate effectively. All permissions requested must be allowed. Testing with Guardians confirms that all permissions are correct, and everyone knows what to expect.
